New Student Registration	\$475.00	Fee applies to all freshmen and transfer students.
Activities Fee	\$225.00	Due September 15, 2011. Covers ASB/Activities, Retreat Programs and Campus Ministry Services. Note: Other costs associated with field trips such as tickets and lunches are not included in this fee.
Senior Graduation Fee	\$175.00	Due March 15, 2012. Required fee for all Seniors.

Football Supplemental Accident Insurance	\$58.00 (approx.)	All players (Fr/JV/Varsity) must purchase supplemental accident insurance before starting practice.
